
PRIVACY POLICY

BACKGROUND:

Worldwebforum beecom AG ("Worldwebforum") understands that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how your personal data is used and shared online. We respect and value the privacy of everyone who visits this website, www.worldwebforum.com ("Website") and (subject to the limited exceptions in section 4, below) we do not collect personal data about you unless you contact us (see section 5, below). Any personal data we do collect will only be used as permitted by law.

Please read this Privacy Policy ("Policy") carefully and ensure that you understand it. Your acceptance of the Policy is deemed to occur upon your first use of the Website. If you do not accept and agree with this Policy, you must stop using the Website immediately.

1. Definitions and Interpretation

In this Policy, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

“personal data”	means any and all data that relates to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified from that data. In this case, it means personal data that you give to us via the Website. This definition shall, where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the Swiss Data Protection Act (as revised from time to time) ("DPA") and/or the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"); and
“we/us/our”	means Worldwebforum beecom AG, a limited company registered in Switzerland whose address is Aargauerstrasse 180, 8048 Zurich, Switzerland.

2. What Does This Policy Cover?

This Policy applies only to your use of the Website. The Website may contain links to other websites. Please note that we have no control over how your data is collected, stored, or used by other websites and we advise you to check the privacy policies of any such websites before providing any data to them.

3. Your Rights

- 3.1 As a data subject, you have the following rights under the DPA and/or GDPR:
 - 3.1.1 The right to be informed about our collection and use of personal data;
 - 3.1.2 The right of access to the personal data we hold about you (see section 4);
 - 3.1.3 The right to rectification if any personal data we hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete (please contact us using the details in section 8);
 - 3.1.4 The right to be forgotten – i.e. the right to ask us to delete any personal data we hold about you;

- 3.1.5 The right to restrict (i.e. prevent) the processing of your personal data;
 - 3.1.6 The right to data portability (obtaining a copy of your personal data to re-use with another service or organisation);
 - 3.1.7 The right to object to us using your personal data for particular purposes; and
 - 3.1.8 Rights with respect to automated decision making and profiling.
- 3.2 If you have any cause for complaint about our use of your personal data, please contact us using the details provided in section 8 and we will do our best to solve the problem for you. If we are unable to help, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Swiss Federal Data Protection and Information Officer ("FDPIC") and/or any competent EU supervisory authority (as the case may be).

4. What Data Do we Collect?

- 4.1 Subject to section 5.2, we do not collect any personal data from you. We do place cookies on your computer or device. In this context please refer to our Cookie Policy https://worldwebforum.com/wp-content/uploads/2018/04/Cookie-Policy_Draft-15-April-2018.pdf
- 4.2 If you send us an email, we may collect your name, your email address, and any other information which you choose to give us.

5. How Do we Use Your Data?

- 5.1 If we do collect any personal data, it will be processed and stored securely, for no longer than is necessary in light of the reason(s) for which it was first collected. We will comply with our obligations and safeguard your rights under the DPA and/or GDPR at all times. For more details on security see section 6.3, below.
- 5.2 As noted above, we do not generally collect any personal data. If you contact us and we obtain your personal details from your email, we may use them as follows:
 - 5.2.1 [To reply to your email;]
 - 5.2.2 [<<add further uses as required>>.]
- 5.3 You have the right to withdraw your consent to us using your personal data at any time, and to request that we delete it.
- 5.4 We will not share any of your data with any third parties for any purposes.

6. How and where do we store your Personal Data?

- 6.1 We only keep your personal data for as long as we need to in order to use it as described above in section 5, and/or for as long as we have your permission to keep it.
- 6.2 Your data will only be stored in the Switzerland.

OR

- 6.2 [Your data will only be stored within the European Economic Area ("the EEA")

(The EEA consists of all EU member states, plus Norway, Iceland, and Liechtenstein).]

OR

- 6.2 [Some or all of your data may be stored outside of the European Economic Area (“the EEA”) (The EEA consists of all EU member states, plus Norway, Iceland, and Liechtenstein). If we do store data outside the EEA (this may be the case, for example, if our email server is located in a country outside the EEA), we will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data is treated as safely and securely as it would be within Switzerland and under the DPA and/or GDPR including Standard Contractual Clauses, Swiss Transborder Data Flow Agreement, etc.]
- 6.3 Data security is very important to us, and to protect your data we have taken suitable measures to safeguard and secure any data we hold about you (even if it is only your email address).

7. How Can You Access your Personal Data?
